

APMSA SHORT TERM GOALS

- A. Improve communication within delegations and with students at each school. Delegations are encouraged to meet together on a frequent and regular basis. In addition, an air of cooperation should be developed between APMSA and local school student governments if this currently does not exist. All students involved in the political aspects of podiatric medicine are working toward common goals and should work together to fulfill those goals.
- B. Increase first year participation in the HOD and eliminate the distinction between delegates and alternate delegates as it relates to fulfillment of duties and participation of activities within the APMSA. Beginning with Orientation, an effort will be made to encourage first year delegates/alternates to be fully involved in all House activities, including discussions, committees, and elections.
- C. Improve awareness of the Corporate Advisory Board and its members. Delegates should continuously promote CAB to their schools and educate fellow students about the support CAB shows through projects and gifts to students. A possible changes in the CAB Reconstruction and awareness poster for each school.
- D. Increase productivity of the APMSA through the encouragement of new and stimulating ideas. To improve the organization and efficiency of meetings, delegates are urged to provide materials in advance for all items of new business. When new items are added during the meeting, they must be presented in written format.
- E. Better financial understanding of the budget with the help of the accountant.
- F. Continue to provide an orientation for new members of the HOD (Presidents, President Elects) so that they will be caught up to speed with meeting structure and current issues of the APMSA.
- G. To bring back official statements through resolutions and to include old resolutions in the agenda book.
- H. Improve morale “project in the works”
- I. Public Awareness. The team felt that in order to increase public awareness our house needs to reach out to the community. It will be encouraged that every member contribute to this project.
- J. The goal of graduation handbook is to increase non-income dues.
